- Validated Competency Framework: The consortium focused on the ESG4VET Competency Framework and the designing of professional development courses (Micro-credentials) specifically for VET trainers.



- ESG Compliance Index: Partners discussed the guidelines and templates for collecting the terms of the European ESG Compliance Index.

- AI & Digital Innovation: The team defined the next technical and pedagogical steps for developing the AI-powered tools and the ESG4VET interactive e-hub.
